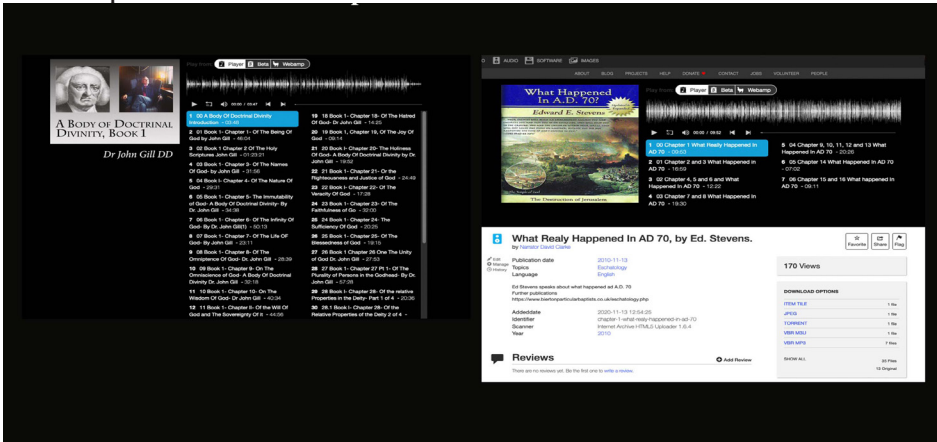


A BODY OF DOCTRINE OF DIVINITY, BOOK 1, Audio Book

Dr. John Gill was an English 17th century reformed Strict Baptists theologian. His complete doctrinal and practical divinity was recently published as a 5 volume set, on 16th January 2020. And presented as a dedication edition to Christ Centred Churches, Phils, Under the care of Bishop William Ola Poloc, its founder and senior pastor (Bishop) of Baguio City, Philippines. It was also presented to Pastor Anil Anwar of Christ Church, Bierton Particular Baptists, Rahim Yar Khan, Pakistan, now to my friends in Finland, Canada, UK and my Preterist friends in the USA.

This work should help our understanding of soteriology as it unfolds the spiritual blessings that we have in Jesus Christ also that God the Father predestined us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself according to the good pleasure of his will.

The gospel teaches us that believers were chosen in Christ before the foundation of the world that we should be holy and without blame, before Him in love. And at the end of all things has come, or will come to pass, according to the good pleasure of his will. So our understanding of the Christian religion must include the Christian doctrine of Predestination.

A correct understanding of soteriology gives a good foundation enable us to understand eschatology and so provide us with doctrinal truth to combat the errors of Catholicism, Arminianism, Islam and any other false schemes of religion, so prevalent today, such as is happening in the Church of England and other national groups such as the Baptist Union Of Great

Britain that has bound themselves by their Declaration Principle, which is an unsound theological statement, coercing and exposing Christians to compromise their faith.

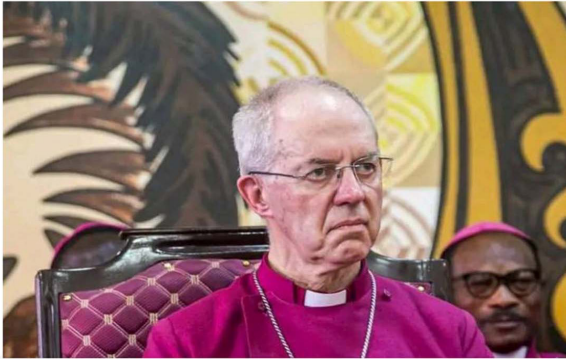

Details of the Council which took place at the Hayes Conference Centre in Swanwick 22-23 November

Same sex relationships/Ministerial Recognition Rules and Guidelines

A presentation was given by the Revd Stephen Keyworth, team leader of the Faith and Society team, and the Revd Dr Paul Goodliff, team leader of the Ministries team.

Council was reminded of the conversations that were encouraged at the Baptist Assembly on same-sex relationships, and was informed of the responses received by the Faith and Society team on the issue, both from individual churches and groups of ministers who had met to engage in the conversation.

The responses fell into three broad categories: those who hold to a traditional line; those who want to hold a traditional line but are struggling for words to be true to their pastoral concerns; and those who are prepared to accept.

More than 90 per cent of churches want to be known as a place of welcome and safety for homosexual people.

The conversation has revealed a range of views on sexuality and relationships within the Baptist family, Stephen said. Disagreement is a reality, and we need to consider how we react to disagreement.

It is important that we understand the attributes and being of God all of which are the basis of theology. Book 1 deals with the following;

Book 1, Of God, His works, Names, Nature, Perfections and Persons.

Book 2 (with book two three and four all contained in one volume)

The Acts and works of God, that includes the decrees of God, Of election and their union to Christ, and the covenant of grace.

Book 3, Of the external works of God, Of the creation of man, his fall the corruption of human nature, and

Book 4, Of the acts of the grace of God towards and upon his elect in time,

The administration of the covenant of grace and the abrogation of the Old Covenant. The law and the gospel


Book 5, Of the grace of Christ in his state of humiliation and exaltation, In the offices exercised by him in the incarnation of Christ

His humiliation, His passive and active obedience, The death burial and resurrection and ascension.

Book 6, Of the blessings of grace and the doctrines of it of redemption. Of the satisfaction of Christ, propitiation, justification, regeneration conversion, sanctification, and the perseverance of the saints. Of the final state of man.

Book 7 Of the death of the body, the immortality of the soul, the separate state of the soul, the resurrection of the body, the Millennium the final state of the Saints.

Now although John Gill's eschatology is Historic we recommend the classic work by James Stuart Russell the Parousia and Edward E. Stevens, What happened in AD 70 to deal with this subject.
