Incorporated, Articles of Religion****We maintain:**

That the scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are given by inspiration of God and are the only rule of faith and practice and that these scriptures reveal the one true and only God who is self existent, infinite and eternal. That there are three self existent co-eternal persons in the Godhead namely the Father the Son and the Holy Ghost and these three are one God and that the Lord Jesus Christ is very God and very man in one glorious complex person.

That God is the creator and sustainer of both spiritual and material worlds.

That the eternal purpose of God in Christ is to manifest his glory.

That Before the world began God did elect a certain number of the human race unto everlasting life and salvation whom He did predestine to the adoption of Children by Jesus Christ of his own free grace and according to the good pleasure of His will.

That God created the first man Adam upright and all his posterity fell in him. Adam was responsible for the fall of humanity.

The effect of the fall left mankind ruined; this included his mind will and affections. Both Adam and his wife Eve were affected in different ways.

That the Lord Jesus Christ in the fullness of time became incarnate and that he really suffered and died as the substitute for his people (the whole world a term used in scripture, expressing both Jew and Gentile). He made all the satisfaction for their sins, which the law and justice of God could require as well as made a way for the bestowments of all those blessings, which are needful for them for time and eternity.

These Articles of Religion are those of the Bierton Strict and Particular Baptist Church, founded in 1832, and of which I joined, in 1976 and where I was called, by the Lord to preach, and sent by the church to preach in 1982, to go where ever the lord opened the door for me to preach. I was a sent minister of the Bierton Strict Baptists Church.

Dear Sir /Madam

I am Rev. William Ola Poloc Sr., the Bishop of Christ-centered Churches, Philippines. Indeed its my pleasure to write to you on behalf of Mr. David Clarke.

My testimony of conversion, and call to preach the gospel of Christ, is told in my booklet, "Called From Darkness Into His Marvellous Light'.

Well, I first met David Clarke in October 2001 who came on a Christian mission to the Philippines to preach the gospel inside the New Bilibid Prison, Maximum Compound. David was the Director of a mission called Trojan Horse International. This mission is recorded in the book, 'Trojan Warriors - Setting Captives Free', by David Clarke.

On August 19, 2002, upon my release from prison, I was commissioned and sent by David Clarke, the Director of the Trojan Horse Mission, to preach the gospel to my own people in the city of Baguio and Benguet Provincial Jails.

I have worked in this capacity, as a sent minister, preaching and teaching the gospel, not only to my own family in my own city but also in other jails and places throughout the Philippines.

In October 2002, I invited Mr. Clarke to visit the work in Baguio City. We went to the Baguio City jail where he preached and eventually baptized 22 inmates who had believed the gospel. We also visited the provincial jail in January, 2003 where he preached and baptized 8 souls who also had turned from crime to Christ.

Since then, I have continually worked and by God's providence founded

several Christ-centered churches throughout the Philippines appointing pastors over which I am an overseer (Bishop). I also confirm their doctrinal foundation that are as those set out in the Bierton Strict and Particular Baptists Church, 1831, of which Mr. David Clarke is the sole remaining member and a sent minister in 1982, as recorded in, 'Let Christian Men be Men' and his book, 'Bierton Strict And Particular Baptists'.

I founded first the Baguio Christ-centered Church, in 2003, which was registered with the Security Exchange Commission in the Philippines and our articles of religion reflect those of the Bierton Strict and Particular Baptists, as outlined in Mr. Clarke's book, *Converted On LSD Trip*, published, 11th February, 2001, and *The Bierton Crisis 1984, Trojan Warriors*, published, September 2002, and now in, 'Let Christian Men Be Men', published 2022.

I also confirm that David attended the 20th Anniversary of Christ-centered Churches in April 2022 and partook in the proceedings.


In addition to this gospel ministry, I am the founding Director and Chairman of the Prisoners For Christ Association, in 2013, which is an association of ex-convicts that meet annually to celebrate and share the work of God entrusted upon us. Last April 19,20,21, we had our 10th Assembly and I invited David Clarke to be our guest speaker at the same time to visit the Christ-Centered Churches.

I also confirm that Mr. Clarke has worked from England in his capacity as the sole remaining member of the Bierton Strict and Particular Baptist Church, and has extended his support to ministry.

He also has republished a range of Theological books, dedicated to our work here in the Philippines, all of which are doctrinally sound, and are useful for those students enrolled in our Theological Institute. They are all theologically sound and monergistic, such as Dr. John Gill's *Body of Doctrinal and Practical Divinity*, and Louie Berkhoff's *Systematic Theology*, along with other related theological books.

I hope this letter of confirmation will serve the purpose for which it is intended and am prepared to visit the UK to confirm if this would help to testify personally to the work.

CONCLUDING NOTE FROM The Director

In the Daily Diary of Trojan Horse International (TULIP) Phils. Incorporated, the back cover suggests that this diary serves to demonstrate the proposition that Jesus gave the command to go into the entire world and preach the gospel, in general rather than specific terms. He did not say how the task was to be done. David purports that the reason why no specific terms were given as to how to go about this task was because had Jesus given a detailed and specific schedule to those who were to carry out the mission it would have proved too daunting to them. So instead He left the methods and practices open to the imagination of men who had been renewed in their minds by the Holy Spirit and with the directions of scripture, with spiritual understanding, would be led to do the work. By this means God would be glorified and often those with a carnal religious mind would be infuriated. It is only when one seeks to obey the command that it is realized that wisdom, determination, courage, skill diplomacy and in fact every skill that man has devised in terms of dealing with money, travel, visa permits, medical practices local laws, legal practices and customs are required. These are not learned by reading a book.

This is not to say those people engaged in the mission will not make mistakes because they will. This is with good reason, for in their weakness they are enabled to look to the Lord, who is their strength, in order to provide all their needs, and so God is glorified. It is also a well known saying the , “He that makes no mistakes makes nothing at all”.

Lessons are learned by mistakes and arm chair critics, who never rise from their comfort zone or arm chair, are unaware that a ship can only be steered when it is on the move.
