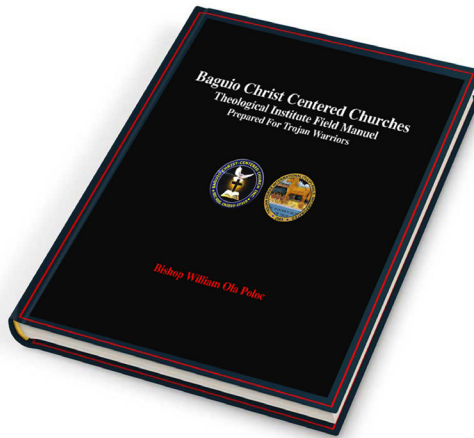


**THIS IS AN ASSIGNMENT MADE NECESSARY WITH A VIEW TO
